1. Venue

Sedgley Park Centre is a Conference and Training Facility run by Greater Manchester Police. Directions and a map are enclosed.

2. Arrivals

On Wednesday 30 June arrivals are from 12noon with lunch available at 1pm with the welcome and introduction to the Conference at 1.45pm.

Gatehouse security at the entrance to the site will inform you where to go for Registration and there will also be member of the Executive on hand.

3. Car Park permit

A permit is enclosed, if requested. If you require a permit please contact Martin Foster. Please fill in your name and car registration number. Sedgley Park advise that the permit does not necessarily guarantee parking on site – though there is street parking outside and one trusts the area is quite safe!

4. Accommodation

All accommodation is in the Clitheroe block. The ensuite bedrooms are equipped with television, telephone, tea/coffee facilities, study area, trouser press, towels and linen

Accommodation at Sedgley Park is usually only available from 2pm. For those not travelling by car there will be an opportunity to leave your bags at security; for those coming by car it may be easier to leave your bags in your car. We have allowed time for people to get to their rooms following the Welcome at 1.45pm.

If you are able to access your room before 2pm you will be informed on arrival at security.
